

**SUBJECT: Process for Accreditation of Joint Education for the Joint and Combined Warfighting School and the Joint Advanced Warfighting School**

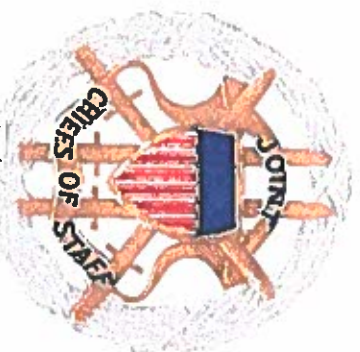
1. The Joint and Combined Warfighting School (JCWS) program accreditation is reaffirmed for 6 years. The Joint Advanced Warfighting School (JAWS) program accreditation is reaffirmed for 2 years. Joint Forces Staff College (JFSC) is authorized to grant Joint Professional Military Education II credit to JCWS graduates through 31 March 2020 and to JAWS graduates through 31 March 2016. Attached are the Process for Accreditation of Joint Education team's reports and certificates of accreditation.
